

Please can you tell me how many taxi tests have been conducted at Warwick driving test centre in 2010 and how many passed at the first attempt?

You can find the number of taxi tests conducted at Warwick DTC and the number of people that passed on their first attempt in 2010 in the table below.

- the above figures are based on a report that was run on 21 January 2011 and they should only be treated as provisional figures. This is because all the information of tests conducted recently will still be in the process of data capture and not yet uploaded onto our reporting system.
- the above information counts the number of attempts since 1 April 2004 and does not include any attempts before this date. If a driver has changed their driver number the count would start again.
