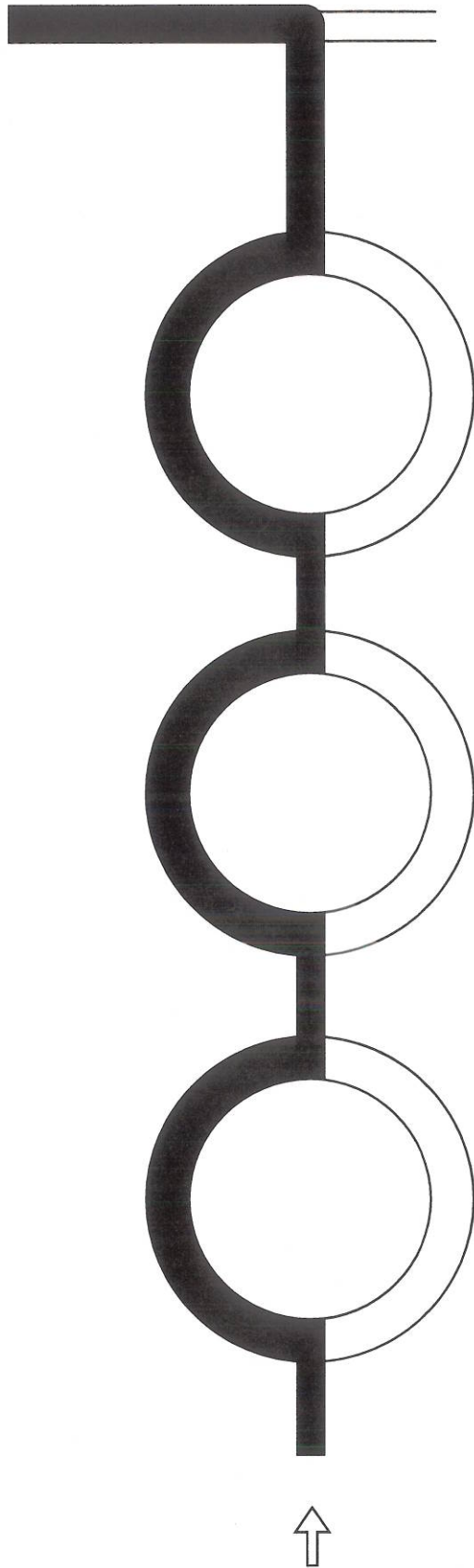

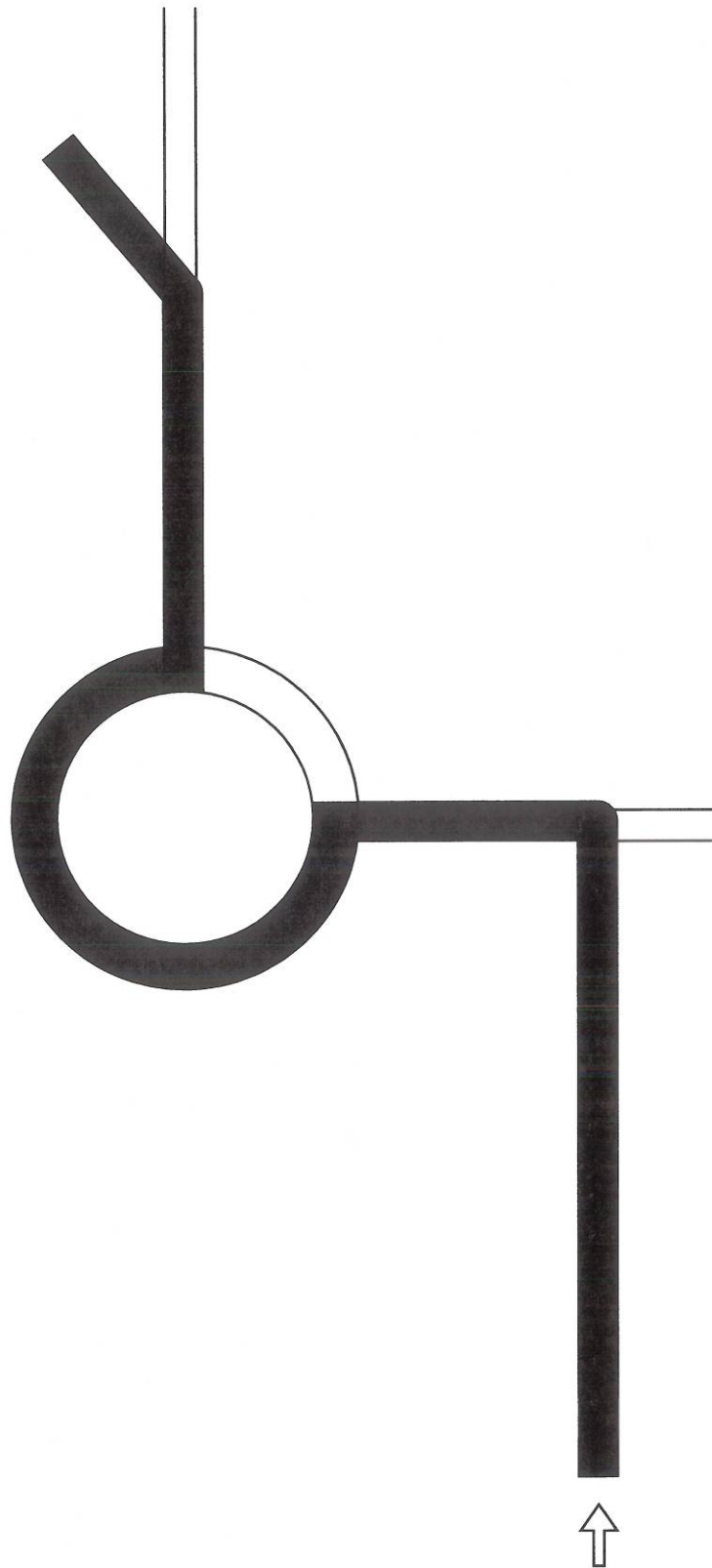

Schematic Symbol Standards

Direction of candidate line to begin and finish with a flat end line. All turns are at 90° with the exception of exits from dual carriageways and bypasses which are 60°. All turns in the road are to have rounded corners as in the diagram opposite. The width of the line is 17pt (5.997mm)

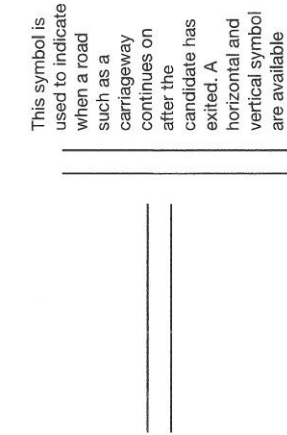


direction line



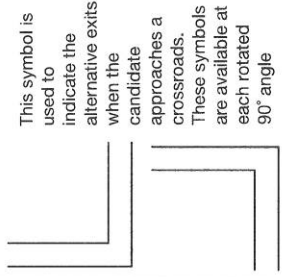
To be used to indicate exits leading up to the exit the candidate should take as shown in the diagram opposite. These symbols are also used to indicate road continuation and alternative directions at the end of the road

road_horizontal/vertical



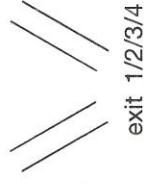
This symbol is used to indicate when a road such as a carriageway continues on after the candidate has exited. A horizontal and vertical symbol are available

road_continuation_horizontal/vertical



This symbol is used to indicate the alternative exits when the candidate approaches a crossroads. These symbols are available at each rotated 90° angle

crossroads_1/2/3/4



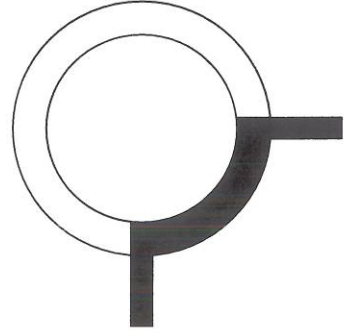
If a candidate is exiting a dual carriageway or bypass these alternative exits should be used as appropriate

exit_1/2/3/4



Start arrow to show where the verbal directions begin

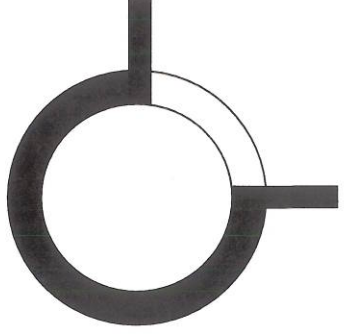

roundabout_left

To be used as described in verbal commands. Exits are not shown on symbols, they are used simply to show the direction the candidate needs to turn (left, straight ahead or right)

Example Directions

- Take the second turning on the right
- At the end of the road turn left
- Turn right at the roundabout
- At the end of the road turn left
- Turn left at the crossroads
- At the end of the road turn right
- Take the second exit along the bypass
