How many pupils on car practical driving tests starting from the Coventry test centre in Bayton Road required an interpreter in 2009, 2010 and so far in 2011.

If the information is available I would also like to know what language the interpreter had to use in communicating with the pupil.

The table below shows the number of car practical tests conducted in 2009, 2010 and up to 31 October 2011 from the Coventry test centre where an interpreter was present. Please note we do not record the language used.
