1) A number of figures within the 'Commentary Part 2' of the bulletin were incorrect.

Impact: Some figures and percentages in "commentary part 2" section of the main bulletin have been amended. All tables and charts were not affected. The amendments are to the following statistics:

- The number of new premises licence applications and the number granted on p29.
- The percentage of newly granted premises licences this accounted for on p29.
- The number of new club premises certificate applications and the number granted on p31.
- The number of variations to club premises certificates applied for and granted on p31.
- The number club premises certificates that were surrendered, lapsed and withdrawn p31.
- The number of applications by the chief officer of police for an expedited/summary review of a premises licence on p36.
- The number of expedited review cases resulting in a completed review of the premises licence on p36.
- The number of interim steps taken following the successful application for the review and the number where no interim steps were taken on p36.
- The number of interim steps for each action following an expedited review on p36.
- The number and percentage of expedited reviews within the two regions reported on p36.

2) Wording within the commentary associated with all the figures affected has been checked and amended accordingly.

3) Additional text was added to the first paragraph on page 30 to state that the 'minor variations' process came into force from 27th July 2009. A footnote was also added to link this to the DCMS guidance on the DCMS website.
