

1. Are there any published vocational licence driver pass rates for tests taken each year? Do DSA have records to show the number of vocational tests taken by category, and the 1st time, 2nd time etc. pass rates.

Please find at Annex B a table which shows the national vocational driving test pass rates by attempt. The statistics have been split by category and gender and shows the amount of tests conducted, passed and the pass rate by the number of attempts.

Please note that we are unable to distinguish between vocational and non vocational tests when running reports by attempts. We can not guarantee that these statistics do not include non vocational test attempts.
