# Appendix 2: Methodology 

This appendix briefly outlines the key elements of the methodology used in conducting the Taking Part Survey, with a particular focus on elements relating to analysis of the data. More detailed information on Taking Part methodology can be found in the survey's technical reports. ${ }^{1}$

## Sample

The 2008/09 Taking Part survey was designed to yield a representative sample of 14,000 adults aged 16+ and 1,200 children aged 11-15 living in private residences in England. In September 2008, the child sample was extended to cover those aged 5-10. Interviews with children aged 11-15 are carried out directly, for those aged 5-10 an interview is conducted with the adult respondent.

The survey uses the residential Postal Address File (PAF) as the sample frame. This provides a list of almost all private residential addresses in the UK and is the most comprehensive frame available. Because it lists addresses, not individuals, in households with more than one potential respondent, the interviewer is required to randomly select respondents at the household.

In 2008/09, the sample yielded 14,452 adult interviews and 2,622 interviews with children aged 5-15.

## Questionnaire and fieldwork

The survey was carried out via Computer Assisted Personal Interviewing (CAPI), with fieldwork conducted from mid-April 2008 to mid-April 2009 by TNS-BMRB. The questionnaire covered: household details, social capital, socialisation, free time activities, engagement with culture and sport sectors, levers and detail of participation, 2012 Olympics, barriers to participation, internet use, volunteering, broadcasting, licensing, and a wide range of demographic details. The full questionnaire is available on the DCMS website. ${ }^{2}$

## Weighting

To correct for different chances of selection due to the number of people living at an address and different rates of response among different population groups, weights were calculated which were applied to the data during analysis. All percentages cited in this report are based on weighted data. The numbers of respondents in the groups on which

[^0]the estimates are based are unweighted. The Taking Part technical report contains further information about how the weights were calculated.

## Confidence intervals and significance

As with all sample surveys, the estimates given in this report represent the mid-point of a range given by their confidence intervals which indicate the range within which the true population value falls. The standard errors for key survey estimates, which can be used to calculate confidence intervals, are given in the 2008/09 technical report.

All differences commented on in this report have been found to be statistically significant at the 95 per cent level. This means that there is a 95 per chance that the observed difference has arisen due to a true difference in the population rather than via random variation

## Analysis and reporting

Where sub-group respondent numbers fall below 30, statistics are suppressed to protect the anonymity of respondents. This is denoted in the tables by an asterisk (*).
