Addendum – amendment tabled February 23

CCGs – Seal and evidence – Amendment 92A

1. This technical amendment would give CCGs the ability to execute a deed, for example where passing a legal title, interest or right in relation to a transfer of land, under seal. The amendment allows a CCG to authorise an individual or individuals, whose signature would authenticate the use of a seal and enables a person authorised by the CCG in circumstances where an individual could do so, to, as an alternative to a seal execute a document on behalf of the CCG with their signature. Where a document purports to be executed in these ways it must be received in evidence on that basis unless the contrary can be proved.
