



- Place the box over the photo, making sure that bottom line (X) of the box is lined up exactly with the bottom edge of the photo.
- Check the eyes fall within the shaded area.
- Check that the eyes are horizontal, or very close to horizontal.

Step 2



- Exactly line up the centre of the eye on the left of the photo (you may use the pupil to assist you) with line Y.
- Check that the centre of the eye on the right of the photo falls within the shaded area.
- N.B: The dotted horizontal line may assist with lining the eyes up.

Step 3

- Check that the subject is facing straight forward and the face is not tilted up/down or facing to the left or right.
- Check that there is nothing covering the subject's eyes (such as hair or the frame of a pair of glasses or glare across lenses of glasses).
- Check that there are no significant shadows over the face or behind the subject.
- Check that the photo is not significantly under or over exposed (too bright or too dark).


