

Request about the level of financial investment given to the London Borough of Lambeth by the Home Office.

Since 2002, substantial sums are, of course, allocated to Lambeth through London wide bodies such as the Metropolitan Police Authority and the Government Office for London.

The attached table gives the level of resource allocated to Lambeth for a range of other activities including community safety and drug treatment.

In addition there are numerous local, voluntary and other grass roots organisation where support funding is provided directly. For example, the Connected Fund, launched in May 2004, provides grants to small voluntary groups working on gun crime and related issues. A number of projects are based in Lambeth and include mentoring schemes, after-school diversionary activities such as sport and music, educational packages and gun crime events.
