



International Citizen Service (ICS), 2012-15 Programme

Statistics on participating UK volunteers, by age and by region

As of 28 February 2013, 1,010 UK volunteers have been / are overseas on placement under the 2012 - 2015 ICS programme¹ which launched in March 2012. The programme aims to successfully place 7,000 UK volunteers, and an equal number of volunteers from host countries, by August 2015.

A regional breakdown of UK volunteers who have taken part in ICS during the full programme is set out in the table below.

In addition to those from the UK, 0.2% of volunteers came from the Channel Islands.

A breakdown of UK volunteers between the ages of 18 and 25 is set out in the table below (ages are based on their age when they undertook their overseas placement with ICS).
