## Freedom of Information request from Xxxxxxxxxxxxx (reference FOICR 23565/12)

Information requested

I would like to know:

How many British Passports are currently held, broken down by country, age or gender if possible?

There is an estimated 48.5 million passports valid in circulation in the UK. This figure is an estimate based on the total number of passports issued in the last ten years and then takes into account that some of these issues would replace passports that had been lost or required replacing for other reasons. We do not collate information on the age demographic nor UK country of issue.

How many passports are reported lost each year, again if possible broken down by age or gender?

→ Also if available where it is they think they lost them i.e. abroad.
