- THE BILL WAS RECEIVED IN THE COMMONS FROM THE HOUSE OF LORDS ON 28 NOVEMBER.
- THE BILL RECEIVED SECOND READING ON THE 18 DECEMBER.
- THE BILL HAD 8 SESSIONS IN A PUBLIC BILL COMMITTEE.
- THE BILL WILL REFORM SOME EXISTING OVERSIGHT ARRANGEMENTS OF THE SECURITY SERVICE, THE SECRET INTELLIGENCE SERVICE, THE GOVERNMENT COMMUNICATIONS HEADQUARTERS AND OTHER ACTIVITIES RELATING TO INTELLIGENCE OR SECURITY MATTERS; TO PROVIDE FOR CLOSED MATERIAL PROCEDURE IN RELATION TO CERTAIN CIVIL PROCEEDINGS; TO PREVENT THE MAKING OF CERTAIN COURT ORDERS FOR THE DISCLOSURE OF SENSITIVE INFORMATION.

- THE BILL HAS 20 CLAUSES.
- THE BILL WILL MAKE FURTHER PROVISION ABOUT BANKING AND OTHER FINANCIAL SERVICES, INCLUDING PROVISION ABOUT THE FINANCIAL SERVICES COMPENSATION SCHEME; TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE AMOUNTS OWED IN RESPECT OF CERTAIN DEPOSITS TO BE TREATED AS A PREFERENTIAL DEBT ON INSOLVENCY; TO MAKE PROVISION ABOUT THE ACCOUNTS OF THE BANK OF ENGLAND AND ITS WHOLLY OWNED SUBSIDIARIES.

- THE BILL HAS 41 CLAUSES AND 19 SCHEDULES.
- THE BILL HAD 13 SESSIONS IN A PUBLIC BILL COMMITTEE.
- THE BILL WILL CREATE THE NATIONAL CRIME AGENCY, ABOLISH SERIOUS ORGANISE CRIME AGENCY AND NATIONAL POLICING IMPROVEMENT AGENCY; ESTABLISH AN UPDATED FRAMEWORK FOR THE RETENTION AND ACQUISITION OF COMMUNICATIONS DATA; ALLOW BROADCASTING OF COURT PROCEEDINGS IN SOME INSTANCES.
