Number of live-play and tabletop exercises held within the National Counter Terrorist Exercise Programme 2007-2009 (2 Feb)

The Government and the emergency services regularly train and practice responses to a range of incidents, including natural disasters and accidents.

The Office for Security and Counter Terrorism leads and manages the UK's National Counter Terrorism (CT) Exercise Programme in co-operation with the Association of Chief Police Officers.

This programme is among the best in the world and is a vital part of resilience and contingency planning. It enables us to test plans and systems thoroughly, train frontline responders, and highlight vulnerabilities.

The National CT Exercise Programme is dynamic and ensures that exercises reflect the changing nature of the terrorist threat worldwide.

In agreement with Chief Constables, it was comprehensively revised and remodelled in 2008 to better support counter terrorism preparedness nationwide.

What does the programme involve?

The exercise programme has been running for over 30 years and:

- is centred on three annual, national-level, live exercises involving police forces, the security and intelligence agencies, the Armed Forces and other government departments
- serves to devise, maintain and regularly exercise those capabilities and responses which would be of key importance in the event of a terrorist incident
- further improves the abilities of the police service and other key partners to prepare for, respond to, and manage terrorist investigations and incidents.
- is designed to ensure each of the nine ACPO policing regions, and Scotland, host a live exercise in turn. At least two police forces within a region are involved to test cross-border policing and interoperability.
- also exercises the way that the local response to a terrorist incident and the response from central government link up.

National CT exercises are the culminating event of a structured series of smaller scale preparatory exercises. These may include tabletop, tactical field training and other exercises aimed at developing greater CT preparedness. Both live and tabletop exercises cover a range of scenarios.

The programme forms an important part of counter terrorism work because it ensures we are prepared to respond to any kind of terrorist attack and that our counter terrorist arrangements are thoroughly tested.

The programme comprises exercises that involve elements of live-play and table-top exercises. Between 2007 and 2009, the Home Office delivered the following counter terrorist exercises as part of this programme:
