AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO THE CONCESSION AGREEMENT RELATING TO THE DEVELOPMENT, FINANCING, CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A FIXED LINK ACROSS THE ENGLISH CHANNEL, SIGNED AS OF 14TH MARCH 1986.

Considering the Treaty between the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the French Republic concerning the construction and operation by private Concessionaires of a Channel Fixed Link, ratified on 29th July 1987 and in particular article 14.

Considering the Concession Agreement signed as of 14th March 1986 between:—

on the one hand, the Secretary of State for Transport in the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Ministre de l'Urbanisme, du Logement et des Transports representing the French State and

on the other hand, the Channel Tunnel Group Limited and France Manche S.A.

The parties to the Concession Agreement agree

Article 1: Clause 3.2 of the Concession Agreement relating to the development, financing, construction and operation of a Fixed Link across the English Channel, signed as of 14th March 1986, shall be modified as follows:—

“Clause 3.2. The Concession Period shall come to an end on the 65th anniversary of the date on which this Agreement comes into operation.”

Article 2: The provisions of Article 1 above take effect on the day of signature by the four contracting parties, of the present amendment in four copies, each in English and French texts, both texts being equally authoritative.
