NAME REDACTED mentioned yesterday that DECC have not been briefed on the activities going on in Europe around the stress testing criteria and how these could impact the UK operating fleet and New Build. It would be useful I suspect to arrange a briefing of Hergen and other members of DECC on the on-going activities. We have a few pieces of information from STUK, WENRA and internal to EDF that may form the basis of a good conversation. I suggest that NAME REDACTED, NAME REDACTED and I provide the briefing with support from your team.

Attached are a series of questions STUK have provided TVO around their operating fleet and OL3. They are expected to provide answers later this week. WENRA provided a proposal to ENISS yesterday at a first round discussion on the European Tests. NAME REDACTED was in attendance at that meeting. These two documents can form the basis for a good briefing. The documents are sensitive and I do not believe are in the public domain. We need to treat them as such.
