Dear Colleague

I wanted to share with you a letter which is being sent from the Secretary of State to all GPs and Practice Managers in England.

The letter responds to conversations that the Secretary of State has been having with General Practitioners over recent weeks and provides clarity on a number of areas relating to:

- what responsibilities GPs would be expected to undertake in their new role in commissioning consortia;
- what support they will receive to help them in the transition period;
- the next steps, using practice based commissioning consortia to shadow potential future arrangements;
- some clarification on organisational structures and governance.

In the letter the Secretary of State encourages GPs who are scoping the development of consortia in their area to approach their PCTs soon with a view to making progress under existing arrangements. The letter can be found at
