## Armed Forces Redundancy Programme Tranche 3 Statistics

## 18 June 2013

## Statistical release

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This publication contains information on the numbers of Armed Forces personnel either applying or selected for redundancy in Tranche 3 of the UK Armed Forces Redundancy Programme. Not all of those who applied were selected, and not all of those selected had applied for redundancy. The publication also details the maximum numbers that could have been selected for each rank and trade.

Tranche 3 of the AFRP concerned the Army only.

## Key Points

- At the end of $18^{\text {th }}$ June 2013, 4,450 Army personnel, of whom $84 \%(3,740)$ were applicants, were due to be selected for redundancy. Due to appeals, transfers and personnel leaving for other reasons, this may not reflect the number of personnel that will eventually leave the Army in Tranche 3.
- 6,210 personnel applied for redundancy in Tranche 3. Not all applicants were selected, where the number of applicants exceeded the maximum for selections in their field. Fields were based on rank, trade and length of service according to the anticipated future structure of the Army.
- Statistics on the number of personnel leaving the Armed Forces on redundancy (all Tranches) can be found in the Defence Statistics Quarterly Personnel Report, which is available at www.dasa.mod.uk under the National Statistics heading.

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## Release notes and definitions

The statistics in this report represent those who applied and those who were due to be notified of selection for redundancy at the close of business on June $18^{\text {th }}$ 2013. They do not necessarily match the numbers of personnel eventually leaving the Services under the AFRP, due to appeals, movements of personnel into different roles not affected by AFRP and outflow for other reasons in the intervening time.

They will also not match numbers of selections compiled before or after $18^{\text {th }}$ June for the same reasons - the lists held by the Services are live lists which could be updated daily. On 17 June 13, the Ministry of Defence issued a press release quoting a figure of 4,480 selections. That figure was compiled earlier in June, and circa 30 personnel were removed from the selections list by the end of 18 June 2013.

## Data Sources

Lists of applicants, selections and fields were obtained from the single Services. All data on personnel characteristics (age, sex, etc) were sourced from the Joint Personnel Administration system with a situation date of 1 June (the date closest to the selections.)
