FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

Thank you for your email sent to the Scotland Office on 12 March 2013.

You asked for the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000:

For each of the items below, please provide the relevant information for your department. Where it is practical to do so, please also provide information for any executive agencies or public bodies that your department is responsible for, on an organisation-by-organisation basis.

For the current financial year, or alternatively for the most recent comparable period for which the information is available, please provide:

1. The total ICT budget for your organisation and an itemised list of the following:
 - a. Current ICT contracts and their respective suppliers. For each I would like to receive brief information on the main purpose of the contract, its cost, its start date and its duration.
 - b. The number of end-user devices belonging to your organisation in each of the following categories: (i) desktop computers, (ii) laptop computers, (iii) tablets, and (iv) smartphones. Please provide information on the operating system and software that is typically provided with devices in each category.
 - c. The number of end-user devices belonging to your organisation reported lost or stolen in each of the following categories: (i) desktop computers, (ii) laptop computers, (iii) tablets, and (iv) smartphones.
2. The domain names (e.g. "example.com") of the ten websites most frequently accessed from end-user devices belonging to your organisation.
3. The total number of email messages sent from email addresses belonging to your organisation's domain (e.g. "abc@example.gov.uk"). Please break this down into the number that were sent to:



- a. *Other email addresses in your organisation (i.e. belonging to the same domain).*
- b. *External email addresses.*

I am writing to confirm that the Scotland Office has now completed its search for information.

The Scotland Office's information technology is provided by the Scottish Government. The Scotland Office does not hold the information requested except in respect of 1 (b) and 1 (c).

In respect of: 1(b) (i) we have 46 desktop; 1(b) (ii) 34 laptop computers. [The total charge paid in for using these computers was £62,468.77.] The Scotland Office uses Microsoft Office, Outlook and Internet Explorer. All of this information relates to the position as at the end of the calendar year 2012. No staff have been issued with smartphones or tablet computers.

In respect of 1 (c) no items were reported lost or stolen in the calendar year 2012.

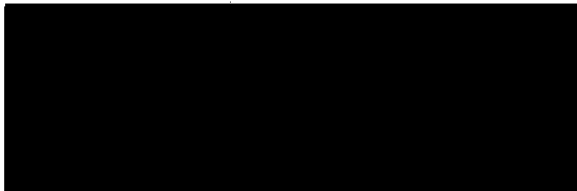
