# **Environmental Protection Expenditure by Industry, 2011**

## **Headline Messages**

- Total spending by UK business in 2011 on environmental protection expenditure was estimated at £3,001 million
- Operational expenditure totalled £2,422 million and capital expenditure £317 million, with research and development accounting for £262 million
- The leading spending industries were energy production and distribution (21%) and food and drink (11%)
- Spending per employee was highest in the in the coke and refined petrol sector and energy production and distribution. Relative shares of total spending by environmental media were solid waste (32 per cent), waste water (24 per cent), air (17 per cent), nature protection (15 per cent), all other (5 per cent), soil and groundwater (4 per cent) and noise (1 per cent)

#### **Background Information**

Defra's Environmental Protection Expenditure by Industry survey is an annual survey of United Kingdom businesses in the extraction, manufacturing and energy and water supply sectors. Environmental protection expenditure is spending incurred by the company where the primary aim is to reduce environmental pollution caused during operations. The survey provides information on operational and capital expenditure, as well as by type of environmental medium to which the spending relates (e.g. air, waste water, solid waste). Operational spending includes both internal and external costs. Capital spending covers both integrated processes and end-of-pipe investments.

Table A shows Environmental Protection Expenditure from 2009 to 2011 broken down into the two types of expenditure (Operational Expenditure and Capital Expenditure) and research and development. Table B shows this breakdown by industry group categorised according to the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC).

#### **Notes**

- 1. The survey is intended to meet the requirements of the EU Structural Business Statistics Regulation 58/97.
- 2. The survey methodology for 2011 differed from the survey for 2010 as it only collected data from a selection of industries and therefore data for SICs 13-15,16,17,18,22-23,29-33 are estimated. The methodology for this estimation can found in the separate <a href="Methodological Note">Methodological Note</a>.
- 3. As the survey results can fluctuate noticeably from year to year due to the low level of response (typically around 20-30 per cent) and because of changes in survey methodology, absolute comparisons with earlier years should be treated with caution.
- 4. Whilst the survey has not been subject to National Statistics assessment standards, it has been conducted and analysed in line with the <a href="Code of Practice for Official Statistics">Code of Practice for Official Statistics</a>.
