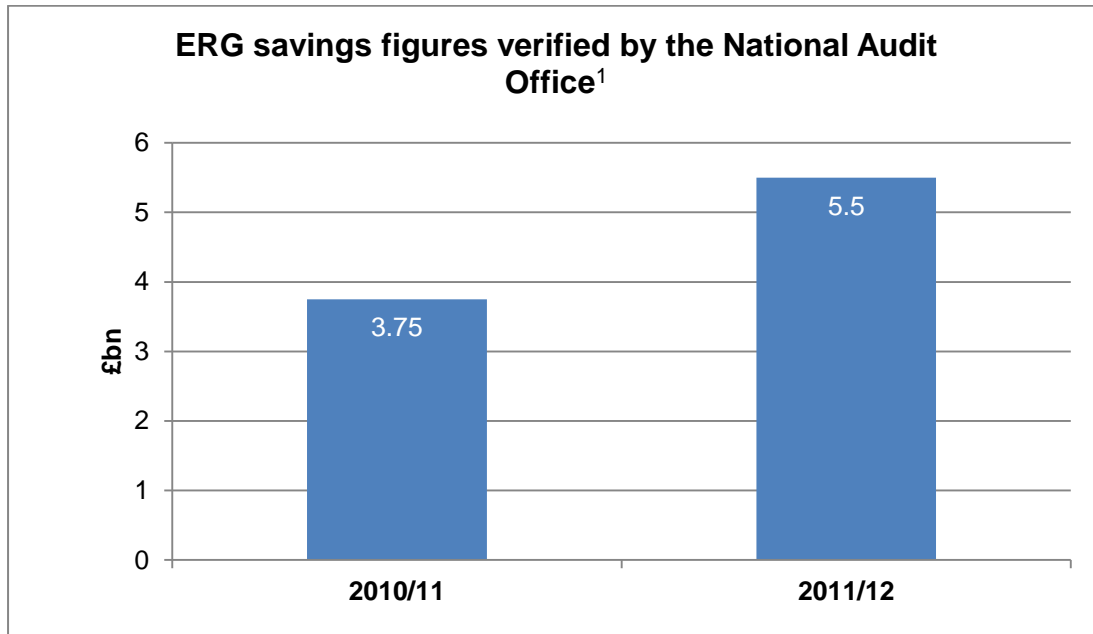
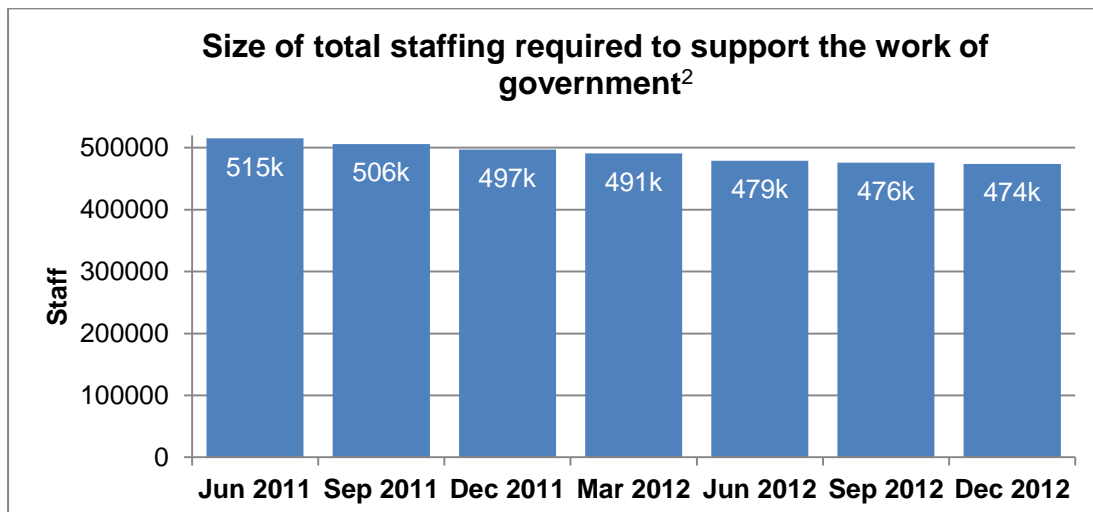


The department has adopted a number of input and impact indicators to help the public assess the effects of our policies and reforms on the cost and impact of public services.

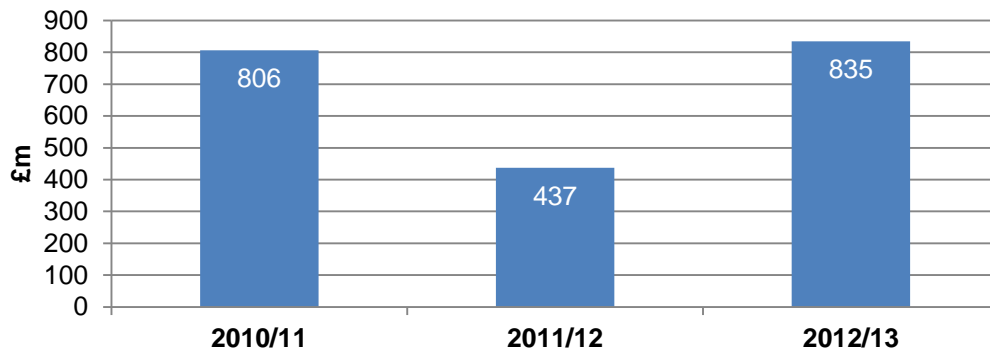

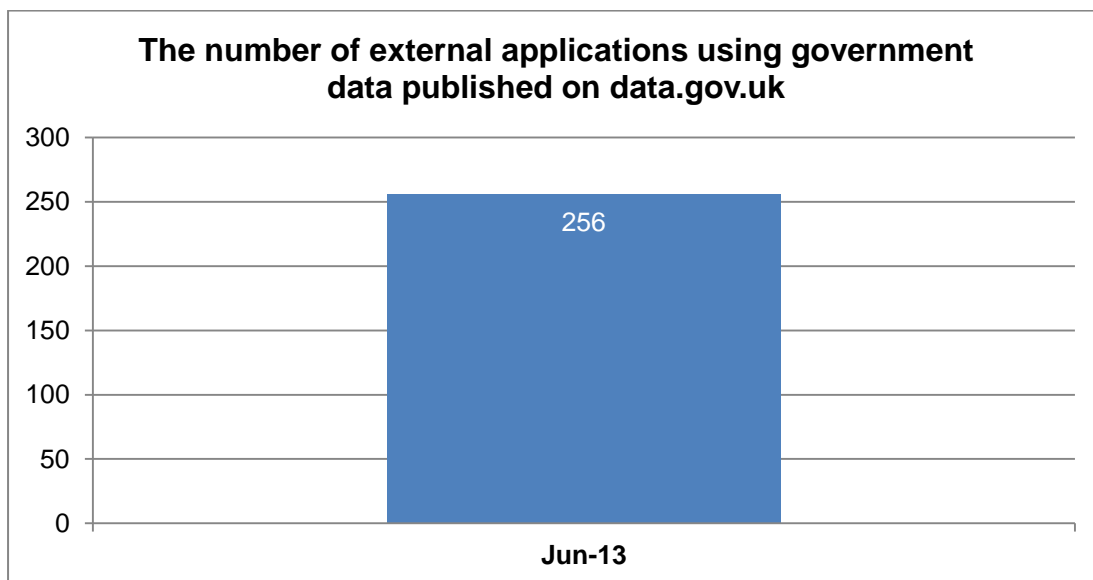
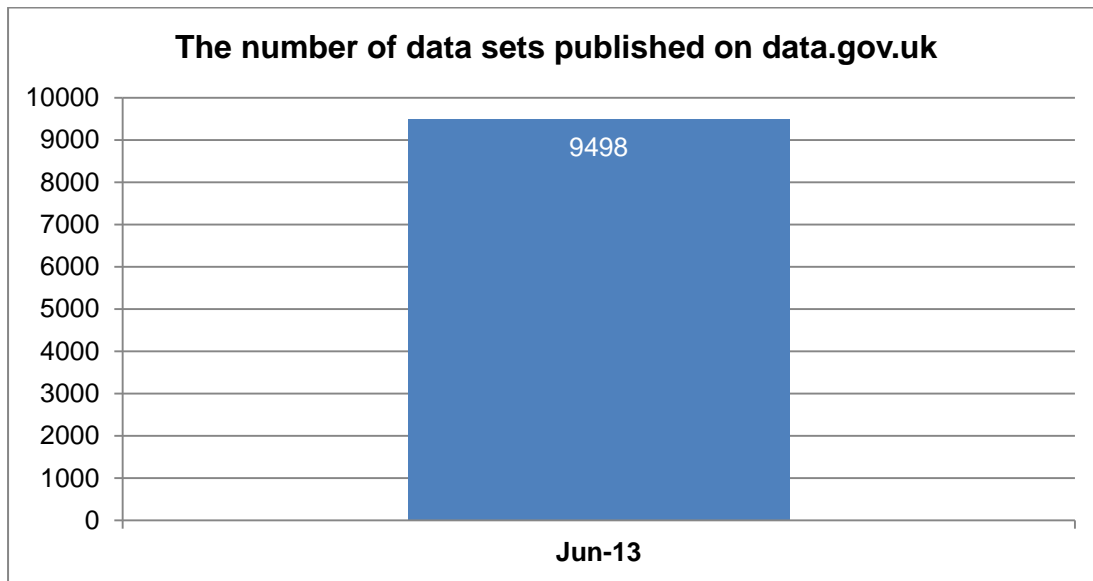
**Total savings made by improved management of relationships with key government suppliers**



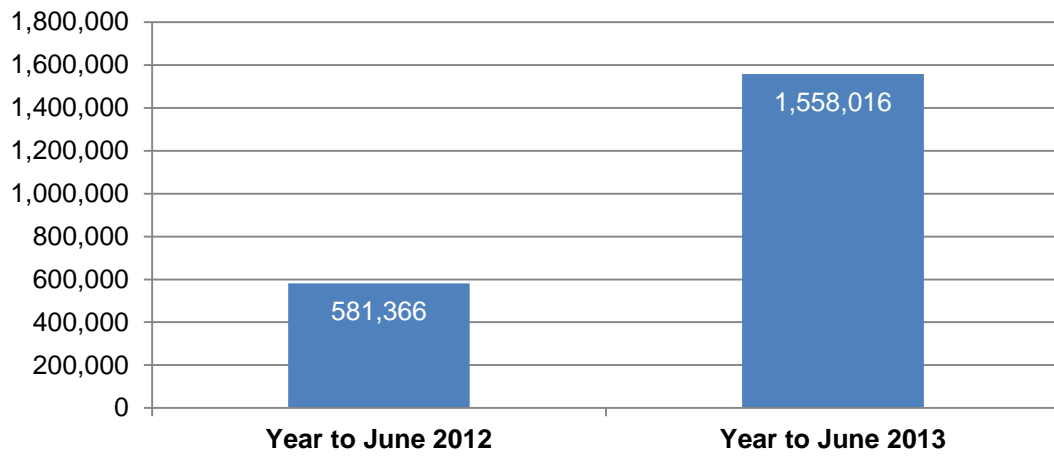
**For every pound spent by government departments, the cost of running a central procurement function to buy common, standard government supplies and equipment**



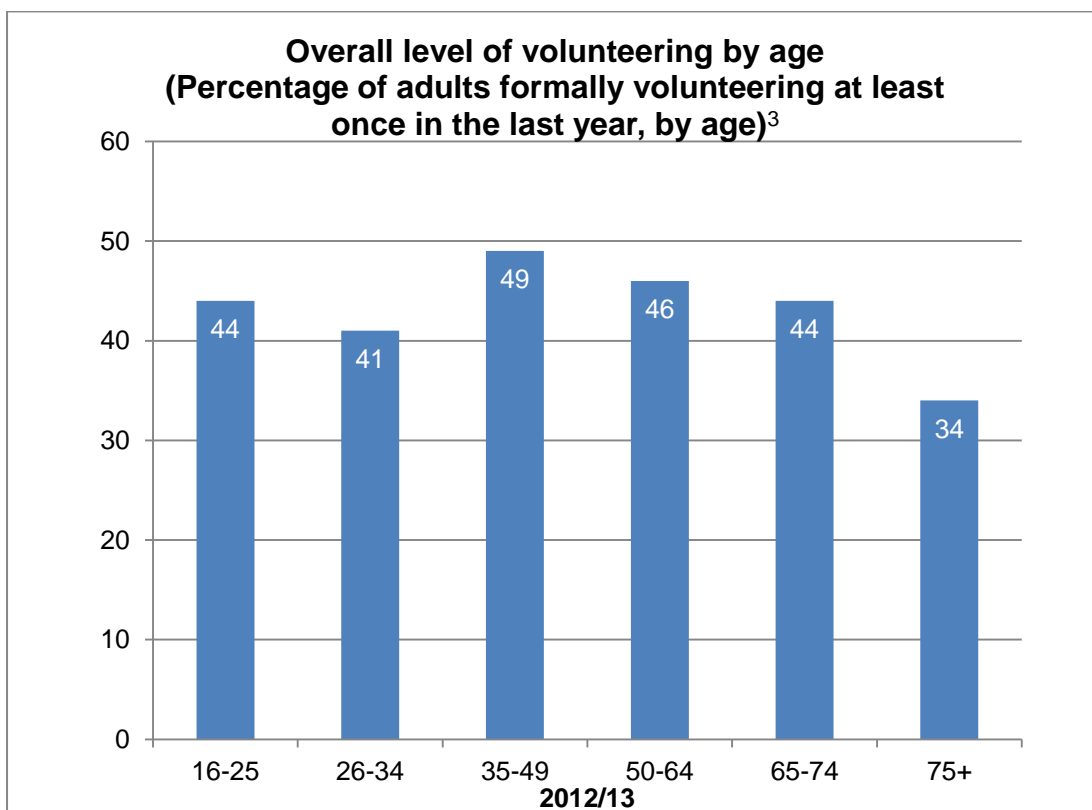
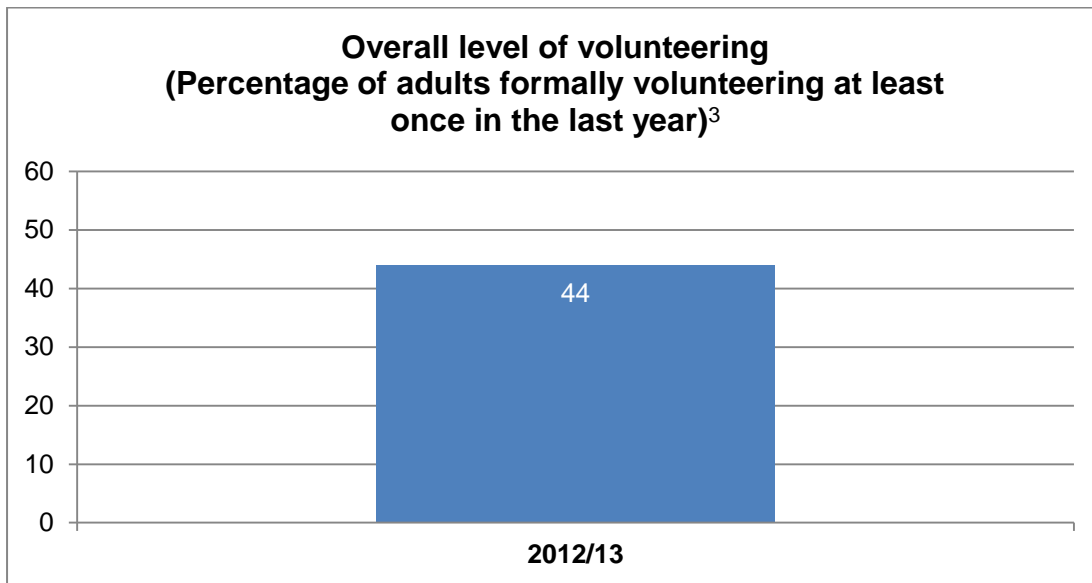

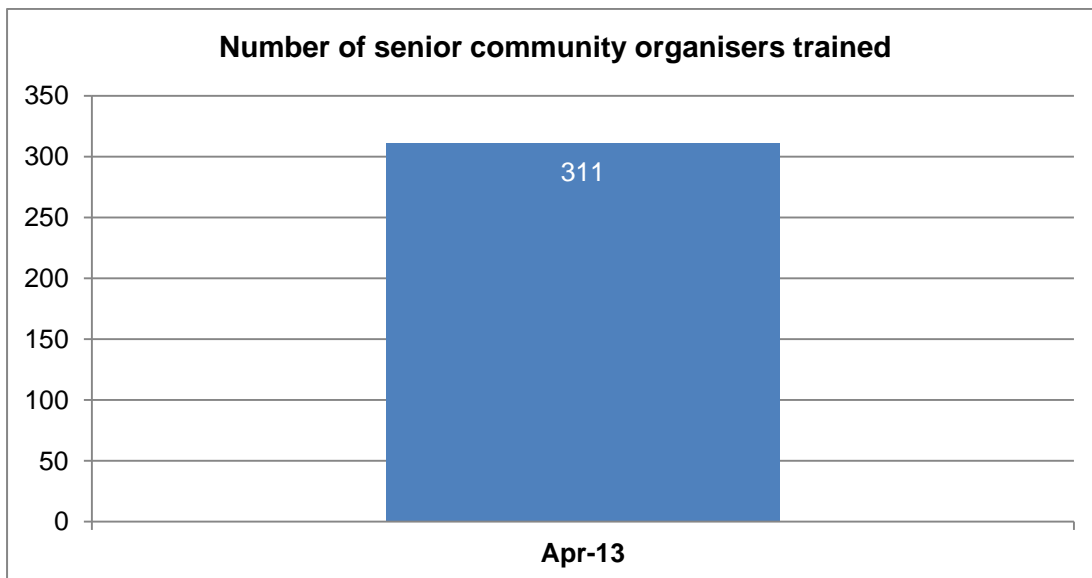
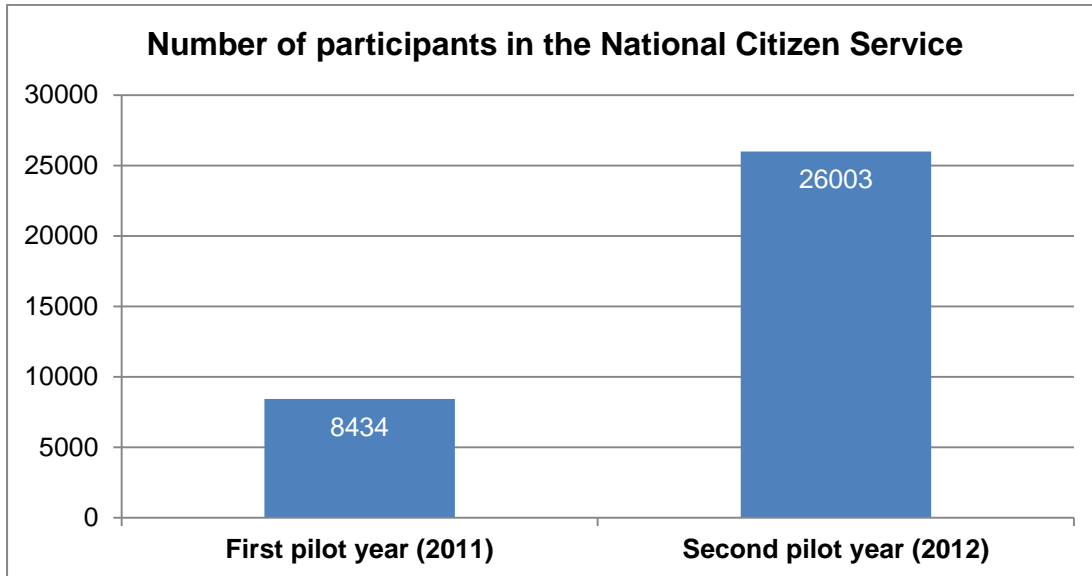
### Number of unique visitors to data.gov.uk increases yearly

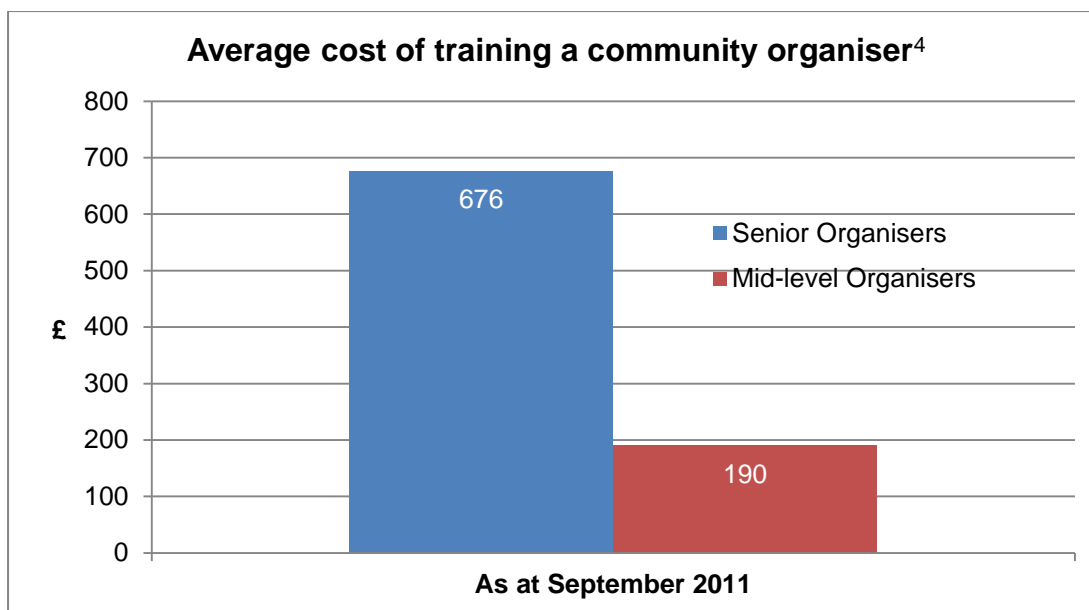

<sup>3</sup> These statistics are taken from the Community Life Survey, a new survey providing Official Statistics on areas such as volunteering, charitable giving and community engagement. Prior to this survey going live, volunteering statistics for this indicator were taken from the Taking Part Survey - a survey looking into engagement with culture, media and sports. Due to the narrower focus of the Taking Part survey the two estimates of volunteering are not directly comparable. The Community Life Survey provides a comprehensive estimate of volunteering, comparable to previous estimates provided by the Citizenship Survey, and as such will be used to provide estimates for this indicator in future.
