ITEM 1: UNANNOUNCED VISITS

ITEM 2 : SOFTWARE UPDATE FOR UTP10 PROGRAMMER

ITEM 3: CONFIRMATION OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ASSESSMENT TO EXTEND A CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCE

The assessment to extend a certificate of competence **must** include the following:-

- Update on recent changes to UK legislation relating to Tachograph Workshops and EU legislation relating to Tachographs. (i.e. Recording Equipment Legislation) (To be given to the technicians in writing as evidence that they have been retrained with appropriate legislative updates)
- Technical updates on new equipment and software. To also include updates to the ATCM and in particular the Special
- Notices.(to be given to the technicians in writing as evidence that they have been retrained with appropriate technical updates)
- A practical assessment of the ability to undertake an accurate calibration.
- Formal written Examination with an 80% minimum pass mark

ITEM 4: SENDER PLASTIC SHROUD SEALS

Centres are reminded that the plastic shroud type seals fitted by some manufacturers to seal senders to gearboxes are to be replaced with a wire and lead seal showing the tachograph centre's sealing number whenever a calibration/inspection is undertaken to the tachograph system. Failure to comply with this requirement may lead to enforcement action being taken against the Centre.

ITEM5: MANDATORY NOTIFIABLE CHANGES

VOSA (tachosection@vosa.gov.uk) **must** be notified when a Tachograph Centre has changed its Designated Manager or QC person as updated documentation is required to be issued. Failure to comply with this requirement may lead to enforcement action being taken against the Centre.

ITEM6: QUALITY CONTROL

Designated Managers are reminded that where a Centre only employs one trained technician and has no other suitable person employed at the Centre to be the nominated Quality Controller, must make arrangements for a suitable external Quality Controller to carry out the checks. Failure to comply with this requirement may lead to enforcement action being taken against the Centre.
