1. I am glad to announce that France will offer the voluntary use of EMTOC in 2012.
2. Furthermore, we are almost finished with drafting the Cooperation Agreement of EMTOC, which describes the responsibilities of regulators and reporting parties in

using EMTOC. The Cooperation Agreement will be closely related to a revised version of the EMTOC Instructions.

When finalised, I will send you a copy for your information (expected mid of August 2012).

One of the main points is that the member state, where you submit your data to, is responsible for the integrity of the data. The Trust Centre (RIVM) and Data Centre (BMG Vienna) are subordinate to the regulators i.e. have no direct legal responsibility towards reporting parties.

As such, the Terms of Use have no longer an added value and will no longer be used.

3. The EMTOC ingredient list (and the Tool) has been updated, and attached. The csv- and xsd- files can be found when you log in in EMTOC.

4. UK and HU have still not formally agreed to use EMTOC. I am waiting for their formal approval.

Confirmed MS: NL, AT, BE, DE, DK, PL, BU, FR.

5. Please remember to transfer for 2012 the yearly payment of €200 per account (MARK with "MS" and "EMTOC").

6. Finally, in some weeks time a new version of EMTOC submission site will be launched providing an extension of possibilities. I will inform you later about the for you relevant new features.
