I am writing in response to your Environmental Information Request sent via email on the 7th January 2014.

Having considered the Request and a number of other similar requests received by the Highways Agency in recent months; I am satisfied that your request forms part of a campaign by a single individual which has developed into a pattern of behaviour that is no longer appropriate or acceptable.

In this case; having reviewed previous emails and considered it is clear that replying to this latest request will only invite further correspondence when there is clearly no willingness by the applicant to engage with the Highways Agency. Therefore I have concluded it is no longer in the Public Interest to do so.

Given the above assessment I have taken the decision to engage Section 12(4) (b) of the Environmental Information Regulations in line with the Guidance issued by the Information Commissioner's Office. The request is therefore refused.
