Child weight management programme and training providers framework: Addendum

This addendum refers to the child weight management programme and training providers framework agreement between the Secretary of State for Health and the service providers HENRY and Weight Management Centre.

This addendum sets out changes to two of the service providers appointed to the framework and includes the following:

- 1) The addition of three age groups to the programme offered by the Weight Management Centre, effective from 29 September 2010 (these additional age groups are highlighted in bold); and
- 2) A transfer of responsibility from the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health to the HENRY charity (highlighted in bold) for the "Let's get healthy with HENRY" programme, effective from 1 April 2010.

These changes are reflected below in a revised table which supersedes that in Section 2, page 11 in the framework guidance document.
