**REQUEST FOR INFORMATION: IDBs and Enclosure Awards**

Thank you for your request for information about drainage works in the area of East Riding District Council, Doncaster, authorised by the Environmental Impact Assessment (Land Drainage Improvement Works) Regulations 1999 since 1 January 2000, which we received on 9 June. As you know, we have handled your request under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIRs).

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, we have not been able to locate any information on drainage works in that area other than the following details:-

Proposed drainage works to construct two new pumping stations in the Fishlake area of Doncaster were authorised under the Environmental Impact Assessment (Land Drainage Improvement Works) Regulations 1999 on 24 May 2013. These works known as the Fishlake Area Mining Subsidence Remedial Scheme are to be carried out by Danvm Drainage Commissioners who are managed by JBA Consulting. The proposed works at Fishlake are part of a wider area which is covered by the Hatfield Thorne Fishlake Enclosure Award of 1825.

For details of other drainage works authorised since 1 January 2000, we suggest that you contact the local drainage authorities in that area.

I attach an annex giving contact details should you be unhappy with the service you have received.
