
Private Sector Employment Indicator



The Private Sector Employment Indicator fell by 760,000 people from its highest in Q1 2008 to its lowest in Q1 2010.

Since then, the Indicator has **Grown** steadily to reach 58.6% in Q1 2013.

This is still **OWER** than its peak in Q1 2008.
