## **Review of TB Eradication Group for England**

- 1. On 3 April 2012, the Animal Health and Welfare Board for England was invited to make a recommendation on the implementation of recommendations from the internal review of the TB Eradication Group (TBEG).
- 2. The Board recommended that:
  - the Board should establish an advisory group on TB eradication as a sub group of the Board. The Board recognised the benefits of an advisory group in communicating progress on bTB eradication to stakeholders;
  - the Board should lead on developing strategy and the advisory group should focus on detailed implementation;
  - the proposed membership profile of the group was correct, the key being to identify individuals with the right skills.
  - wildlife and conservation expertise should be considered if appropriate candidates could be identified.
  - it might also be necessary to involve other experts, for example a scientist and someone with experience of the food industry;
  - the Chair should be an independent person with the right skills;
  - remuneration levels should be at a level to get the right people but a simple approach was preferred.
- 3. The Board invites you to accept its recommendation. If accepted, the TB policy team will advise you on the proposed membership of the new advisory group.
