USE OF GOLD PARTS IN ARTICLES OTHERWISE COMPRISED OF PLATINUM

1. This Notice is issued on behalf of each of the Assay Offices for the guidance of manufacturers and others concerned with articles comprised substantially of platinum.

2. The Assay Offices announce that articles otherwise comprised of platinum which include certain small working parts made of white gold as set out in the Schedule hereto which are submitted for assay and hallmarking will be accepted under paragraph 4 (c) of Schedule 2 to the Hallmarking Act 1973, provided such small working parts are of a standard of not less than 750 parts per 1,000.

3. This Notice shall remain in force until withdrawn by the Assay Offices or by the Joint Committee of the Assay Offices of Great Britain on their behalf.
