The Secretary of State, in exercise of the power conferred by section 58(6)(d) of the Pensions Act 2008(a), makes the following Order.

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Compromise Agreements (Pensions Act 2008) (Description of Person) Order 201[] and shall come into force on [ ].

**Person specified**

2. For the purposes of section 58(6)(d) of the Pensions Act 2008, a person authorised by the Institute of Legal Executives to practise as a member of the profession of legal executives who is practising in accordance with and subject to the regulatory arrangement of the Institute of Legal Executives is specified.

This Order specifies that, for the purposes of section 58(5)(c) of the Pensions Act 2008 (c. 30), a legal executive is a ‘relevant independent adviser’. This means that such a person is validly able to give advice in relation to compromise agreements under that Act.
