## Statistical notice – Changes to the Ministry of Justice Official Statistics Publication Schedule September 2013 to July 2014

### Introduction

This note is to advise users of changes to the publication schedule for Ministry of Justice Statistics covering the period July 2013 to June 2014.

### Summary

The changes are:

a) bringing forward the publication dates for the *Tribunals Statistics Quarterly* as follows:

Tribunal statistics quarterly - January to March 2014	26 Jun 2014	12 Jun 2014

b) bringing forward the publication dates for the *Gender Recognition Certificate Statistics Quarterly* as follows:

Gender recognition certificate statistics quarterly- April to June 2013	3 Oct 2013	5 Sep 2013

c) bringing forward the publication dates for the *Court Statistics Quarterly* as follows:

d) Ceasing the publication of *Judicial and Court Statistics 2013* on 26 June 2014 and incorporating the information into *Court Statistics Quarterly January to March 2014* to be published on 26 June 2014.

e) Ceasing the publication of *Employment Tribunal and EAT Statistics 2012-13* on 5 September 2013 and incorporating the information into *Tribunal Statistics Quarterly April to June 2013* to be published on 26 September 2013.

## Details

*Tribunals Statistics Quarterly*  
*Gender Recognition Certificate Statistics*  
*Court Statistics Quarterly*

There have been improvements made to the processes used to prepare and quality assure the data behind these publications which have significantly shortened the time required to prepare these publications.

Furthermore, the Ministry of Justice have been identified that a number of users of the Gender Recognition Certificate Statistics publication have requested for this information to be released earlier than is currently scheduled.

Therefore, the Head of Profession for Statistics in the Ministry of Justice has decided to revise the publication dates as set out above to improve the timeliness with which the data are released.

### *Judicial and Court statistics 2013*

The Ministry of Justice ceased the production of Judicial and Court Statistics in June 2013 as the majority of this information was already published in *Court Statistics Quarterly*. Any information covered by this publication that is currently not in *Court Statistics Quarterly* will be transferred to this publication.

This will result in one source of information that will always contain the most up to date information. There will be no loss of information from this transfer.

### *Employment tribunal and EAT Statistics 2012-13*

This publication presents information on Employment Tribunals (ET) that is already published in *Tribunal Statistics Quarterly*. This can create confusion for users as there are two alternative sources of information.

The Ministry of Justice intends to cease the production of Employment tribunal and EAT Statistics and transfer any information not in *Tribunal Statistics Quarterly* (specifically information on Employment Appeal Tribunals) to this publication. This will result in one source of information that will always contain the most up to date information. There will be no loss of information from this transfer.

The Ministry of Justice will provide users with a mapping of the old *Employment tribunal and EAT Statistics* tables to their new location in *Tribunal Statistics Quarterly*.
