## Notes

1. Monthly information was requested for each former PCT via the ImmForm website for vaccinations administered since the beginning of September to 31 December 2013.
2. The table shows the provisional number of eligible girls and coverage of first and second doses of HPV vaccine for girls in the routine cohort, school year 8 (aged 11 to 12 years) by former PCT as at 31 December 2013.
3. England coverage is 85% for the first dose and 69.8 % for the second dose as at 31 December 2013. These are similar levels to those achieved in the previous year (as at 31 December 2012 – 86.8% and 68.9% respectively)
4. National, area team and former PCT data are presented.
5. Coverage for the second dose in some former PCTs is low due to a late start of the 2013/14 programme.
6. No data were available for the area corresponding to the former South East Essex PCT where the 2013/14 programme started in January 2014.
7. The 2013/14 programme started late in former Hillingdon PCT and Bexley Care Trust.
8. The next evaluation will be of cumulative coverage as at 31 March 2014. Final annual coverage data will be collected in September 2014 and published by the end of the year 2014.
