Q. Can I complete the Specialist Disability Employment Programmes Consultation on-line?

Q. Will the Specialist Disability Employment Programmes Consultation document be produced in British Sign Language (BSL)?

Q. Will there be consultation events for Remploy employees?
A. A series of regional consultation events has been arranged between 12 and 21 September 2011.

Q. Can I meet the Sayce Review Consultation Team to discuss my views?A. No, sorry, but it is not possible to meet everyone who has an interest in the Sayce Review.

Q. Are there any circumstances in which the deadline for responses to the consultation will be extended?

A. No. To ensure everyone has the opportunity to contribute, this consultation is lasting for fourteen weeks instead of the twelve weeks usually given. All contributions must be submitted by 17 October 2011.

Q. Can I make a contribution anonymously or confidentially?

A. We need a name and contact details in order to ensure that contributions are not duplicated and are from genuine respondents, so we cannot accept anonymous contributions. You can however ask that your contribution is confidential. This means your personal information will not be shared and your contribution would not be quoted in any report. If you would like your

contribution to be confidential you should ask for this clearly and say why, as part of your response.

Q. Can we add a link to the Specialist Disability Employment Programmes Consultation to our organisation's website?A. Yes.

Q. Will all contributions be taken into account?

A. Yes, every contribution that we receive will be taken into account. A summary report of these contributions will be published after the consultation period has ended.

Q. Will my contribution be passed on to any other Department or Agency? **A**. No.

Q. How long will the Sayce Review Consultation Team keep my contribution?A. We will keep paper copies of contributions to the consultation exercise in secure storage for five years. After this time, they will be destroyed.
