REQUEST FOR INFORMATION: Apple Products

Thank you for your request for information about IT management within Defra, which we received on 3 December 2013. As you know, we have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

We have provided answers to your questions below:

1. A list of all the Apple products (eg iPad, iPhone, Macbook etc) purchased by your department since May 2010.

1 X iPad purchased in June 2012 - £399.

1 X iPad received in December 2012/January 2013 - £0 (came from Defra's Tech Fund with Vodafone).

15 X MacBook Air 13 – approx. January 2013. Cost per unit £745, total cost £11,175.

2 X Mac mini dual core – approx. January 2013. Cost per unit £388, total cost £776.

7 X MacBook Air 13 – 1.3 i5, 4GB 128 GB – purchased in September 2013. Cost per unit £745, total cost £5,215.

4 X Mac mini dual core i5 2.5GHz/4GB/500GB/HD – purchased in September 2013. Cost per unit £475, total cost £1,900.

2. In addition to that, the cost of the item and the date that each one was purchased.
