Aquatic Weed Control Operation Phase 3 - Best Practice Guidelines

The control of aquatic plants within river systems forms a significant part of the Environment Agency's annual operational maintenance expenditure. Management of aquatic plants requires

not only efficient control techniques but should also recognise cost-effective and environmentally sensitive solutions.

Aquatic Weed Control Operation Phase 2 produced guidelines on weed control. These guidelines provided a source of information on the range of weed control options available including mechanical, chemical, biological and environmental practices, with guidance and flow charts for the selection of best practice solutions. The guidelines provided Agency staff with information, guidance and opportunities to:-

- manage aquatic plants in an environmentally acceptable manner
- improve specifications for the necessary work
- select the optimum control method
- provide the opportunity for cost savings

The objective of Phase 3 was to translate this guidance into formats which would facilitate the uptake of best practice into all levels of the Flood Defence business. This resulted in the production of a Flood Defence operational manual for use by Agency staff along with a bankside leaflet for use by contractors as well as Agency staff.
