

<p>Overall comments on the robustness of the OIOO assessment.</p> <p>The IA says that the proposal is a deregulatory measure that has a direct net benefit to business (an 'OUT') with an Equivalent Annual Net Cost to Business (EANCB) of -£0.03m. This is consistent with the current One-in, One-out (OIOO) Methodology (paragraph 18) and on the analysis and evidence presented in the IA represents a reasonable assessment of the likely impacts.</p>		
<p>Overall quality of the analysis and evidence presented in the IA</p> <p>The IA clearly sets out the rationale for the proposed changes, and explains how the final version takes account of the consultation responses to develop the evidence base and influence the estimates of costs and benefits.</p>
