Procurement Update

You'll be aware from your engagement with DVLA and from other procurements that the GPS frameworks that are being introduced will play a key role in future ICT procurements. The expectation is that they will be the primary sourcing option for future ICT contracts and DVLA will follow this direction.

DVLA is also engaging in wider discussion with DfT and our sister agencies to consider how we can maximise the opportunities across the Department whilst optimising the opportunities for the market. Where we can identify joint opportunities then we'll look to go to market via GPS frameworks and /or Cloud Store.

Our commitment to engage the market and keep you informed remains unchanged, as does our desire to maximise the contract opportunities for SMEs. As we move forward we may choose to co-ordinate future events and / or communications at a Departmental level.

Short Term Activity

- Continuing development of the Statement of Requirements
- Creation of the transformation route map

Medium Term Activity

- Procurement of tower services
- Complete migration to a fully towerised operating model
- Complete migration to a perpetual contract management model that will support the towerised structure and the variable contract options within it
