PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION

Terms & Conditions

Please read the following before submitting your entry. All entrants who submit images are deemed to have read and accepted these rules and agree to be bound by them.

General

Entries are invited for the “We Are Falklands” competition in the following categories:

Wildlife

Landscapes

Heritage

Island Life

People

This competition is free to enter.

Each entrant can submit a maximum of five photos per category, and a maximum of fifteen photos in total across categories. The complete submission will be considered a portfolio.

All portfolios must be submitted to the FIG PR & Media Office, Gilbert House, either via email

(ehancox@sec.gov.fk or kormond@sec.gov.fk) or by post/in person on a CD/DVD/memory stick.

Each image within the portfolio must be saved in the following format or will not be considered:

First name; Surname; Location; Subject Title

Please ensure that images are 300dpi at A4 size.

All portfolios must be received by the PR Office by 28th March, at the latest

Entry Guidelines

Each entry must reflect the category for which it is entered listed as above.

Acceptable formats are colour or black & white.

Resolution should be sufficient to be printed to high quality (300dpi at A4).

Minor digital adjustments are permitted such as levels, curves, contrast, colour, saturation and sharpening work. However we will only permit images that are a faithful representation of a true moment, not a creation. Adding or removing subjects from the image submitted is not allowed. Composite and multiple exposures are also not permitted.

Watermarks are prohibited.

Black and white shots may be shot in colour and then de-saturated. A duotone or sepia tone may then be applied.

Rules and Restrictions

All entrants must include the following information: Full name, age, address, contact

details and whether they are an amateur or professional photographer.

Photos must have been taken in the Falklands.

Entry is international and domestic to the Falkland Islands.

Entries must be received by Friday 28th March, otherwise they will not be considered.

By submitting, entrants are agreeing to the future use of their images within FIG marketing and promotion.

Photos that have been manipulated digitally outside of the specified entry guideline will be disqualified.

Exhibition and Roadshow

Judging will take place between 31st March – 11th April

Winning photos will be used in the “We Are Falklands” photo exhibition in London, to be printed and displayed at the a central London

gallery later this year with full credit given to the photographer.

Photos will also be part of the Falklands Experience Roadshow in locations around the UK.

All photos entered may be reproduced free of charge by FIG, including but not limited to leaflets, posters and websites, these images will be attributed to the photographer.

Images remain the copyright of the photographer, however the photographer grants FIG non-exclusive rights to free production and exhibition.

There will be up to 40 winning photos – an entrant may have more than one winning photo.

Timing

Closing date for email entries: Midnight 28th March 2014.

Closing date for direct delivery of images via memory stick/CD/DVD: 1630 Friday 28th March.

Tips

Wildlife should be shot ideally in their natural surroundings, whilst captive wildlife shots will be considered, they will not regarded as highly as those shot in the wild.

Please clearly name your images files with your name, shot location and subject title.

Originality is something that the judges will be looking for as well as technical merit.

Judges are looking for shots that really embody the Falklands, so drastic colour alterations or things that look artificially altered will not be chosen as a winner.
