Planned changes - Publication covering Criminal Legal Aid Statistics

Introduction

1. This note is to advise users of a publication covering the use of the Criminal Legal Aid schemes to be published on the 27th February 2014. These figures have not previously been published and are provided prior to the next scheduled publication to meet the public interest in the consultation release.

Summary

2. The annual bulletin presents statistics on the information collected on each legal aid scheme administered by the Legal Aid Agency. It covers the two areas of work, crime and civil, alongside timeliness, the appealing of decisions, information on providers of legal aid and lastly a view of the clients who have used legal aid in 2012/13.
3. The planned changes are to publish volumes and outcomes from Criminal legal aid schemes for an interim period to provide the rolling year to date figures for the latest available data September 2013.
4. This publication providing figures for October 2012 to September 2013 will be published on Thursday 27th February 2014.
