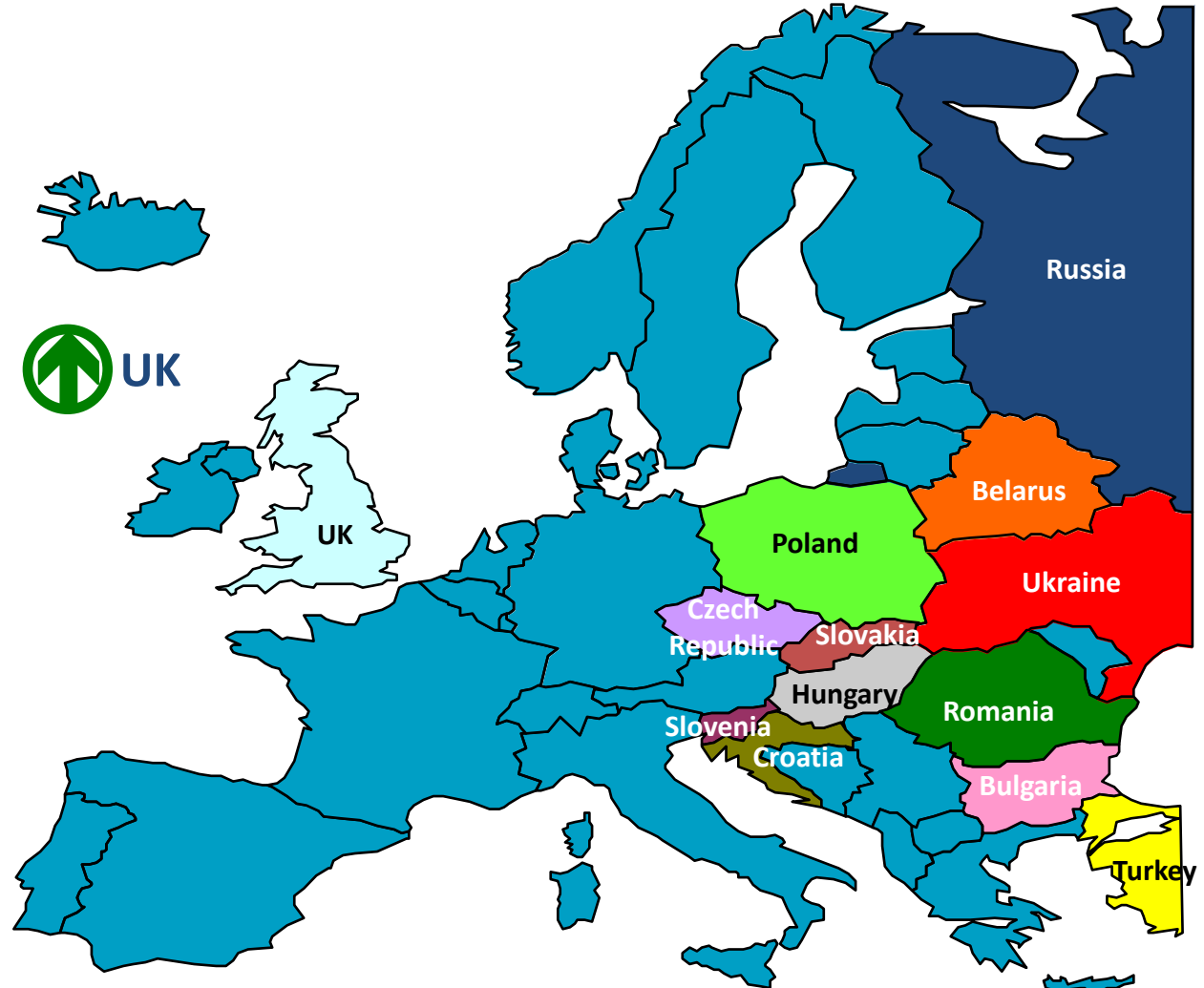

# The nuclear business requires long-term partnerships



- Large reactors, large upfront investment
- Investments recovered and return over 60 years
- Fuel including enrichment required for 60 years
- Interdependency requires partnership between utilities, customers and suppliers
- Long-term contracts give confidence and security to both
- Fair prices needed to support mid-term re-investments in supply chain

# URENCO experience in Czech Republic



- Spot sale, enrichment mid-1990's. Portion of initial core for Temelin 1
- Term contract, portion of enrichment needs for Temelin 1 & 2 from 2004
- Term contact portion of enrichment needs for Temelin 1& 2 from 2013
- Recently bid to supply UF<sub>6</sub> feed material for Czech reactors
- URENCO believes it has good relationship with its Czech counterparty
  - Collaborative relationship on transport and government agency approvals in sometimes complex international logistics in executing contracts
  - URENCO has always delivered on time
  - URENCO has always been paid on time
