#### **FOREWORD**

- 1. These accounts are prepared under section 21(1) of the National Loans Act 1968. They follow the pattern established by previous accounts and include figures for the previous year.
- 2. Part I covers the transactions on the Consolidated Fund in the year ended 31 March 1985 including revenue from taxation and miscellaneous receipts, issues for Supply Services and for those services which, under various Acts of Parliament, are charged directly on the Consolidated Fund. This account also shows the deficit over the year as a whole, which was met from the National Loans Fund under section 18(3) of the 1968 Act.
- 3. Part II gives details of the receipts and payments of the National Loans Fund in the same period, including the payment to meet the Consolidated Fund deficit referred to in the previous paragraph, issues of sterling capital to, and repayments from, the Exchange Equalisation Account, and all transactions in respect of the principal and the service of the National Debt. Details are also given of the issues to Ministers for the purpose of making loans to nationalised industries, local authorities and other borrowers, and of the amounts received in respect of interest on the repayments of such loans. Most of the departmental accounts which record these loan transactions will be published later in a separate volume "Accounts relating to issues from the National Loans Fund 1984–85".
- 4. Further information about the transactions, assets and liabilities of both Funds appears in the Supplementary Statements prepared by the Treasury in accordance with section 21(3) of the 1968 Act (House of Commons Paper No 00 of 1985–86).
- 5. The present accounts show that there was a deficit on the Consolidated Fund in 1984–85 of £7,370 million; loans from the National Loans Fund, less repayments amounted to £2,501 million; net repayments by the Exchange Equalisation Account were £1,000 million; payments totalling £184 million were made to the International Monetary Fund to maintain the value of its holding of sterling; and the National Debt Commissioners made payments totalling £19 million to reduce their liability in respect of the National Savings Bank Investment Fund. Net borrowing by the National Loans Fund in1984–85 was £13,965 million which resulted in a balance on the fund at 31 March 1985, arising from section 152 of the Finance Act 1982, of £4,937 million.

#### Data Protection Act 1984

- 6. Section 3 of the Data Protection Act 1984 provided for the appointment of an officer to be known as the Data Protection Registrar. Schedule 2 (Clause 3) of the Act provides for the Registrar's salary, as specified by a resolution of the House of Commons, to be charged on and issued out of the Consolidated Fund.
- 7. The first Registrar was appointed on 20 September 1984 and his salary is included within the 'Salaries and Allowances' entry on page 5 of the Consolidated Fund account.
