SCHEDULE FOR THE PUBLICATION OF OFFICIAL STATISTICS APRIL 2011 TO SEPTEMBER 2012

INTRODUCTION

This Statistical First Release (SFR) announces the planned schedule for the publication of statistics by the Department for Education (DfE) for the period April 2011 to September 2012. The schedule covers all of the National Statistics and Official Statistics that DfE expects to publish throughout the next 18 months. National Statistics are the subset of Official Statistics that have been assessed or deemed to have been assessed to be compliant with the Code of Practice for Official Statistics.

The schedule lists the National Statistics publications (SFRs, Bulletins and Volumes) and official statistics publications due to be released in each of the next six months, and provides a provisional list for the following twelve months. Specific release dates will be announced at least 4 weeks in advance of release on DfE's Research and Statistics Gateway at <http://www.education.gov.uk/rsgateway/whatsnew.shtml> and on the UK Statistics Authority Publication Hub at <http://www.statistics.gov.uk/hub/release-calendar/index.html>. For statistical releases with fixed release dates, specific release dates are given here in this schedule.

The DfE's Statement of Compliance with the Pre-release Access to Official Statistics Order 2008 at <http://www.education.gov.uk/rsgateway/nat-stats.shtml> sets out the procedures for pre-release access to statistics within the Department. Statistical Releases are normally released at 09:30 and are made available to all users at that time.

REVISIONS TO THE SCHEDULE

If the Department publishes or plans to publish any statistics not listed in the schedule then these statistics will be announced on the Research and Statistics Gateway and UK Statistics Authority Publication Hub mentioned above. If it proves necessary to change any pre-announced release date, an explanation will be provided as far in advance as possible of the planned release date. The next schedule is due to be announced in September 2011.

This schedule covers the period from April 2011 to September 2012 and reflects the position as at the point of publication. Additional ongoing work to reduce data burdens or rationalise outputs may impact on the publication programme. Announcements will be made on our website when definitive information is available. Known changes in scope or discontinuations are listed below.

Change in scope of publication

Schools, Pupils and their Characteristics

This Statistical First Release contained provisional figures and was last published in May 2010. This year, we propose to discontinue the publication of provisional figures and replace the Statistical First Release (provisional figures) and additional tables (final figures) with a Statistical First Release that contains the final figures. This release will be published in June.

Discontinued publications

Youth Cohort Study & Longitudinal Study of Young People in England: The Activities and Experiences of 16-19 year olds, England

This publication reports on the same group of young people annually until age 19. The current group is now 19 and will be reported on in July 2011. A new study has not yet been commissioned and no publication is scheduled for 2012.

Children Missing from Home or Care. LA self-evaluation scores of measures to monitor, respond to and address runaway cases, England

This release was last published in September 2010. This measure was one of the previous government's National Indicators. It is no longer a requirement on Local Authorities to supply the data for this measure, and there is insufficient data available for a further publication.

PE and Sport Survey

This release was last published in September 2010. The Department has stopped collecting these data and there will no further publications.

Effectiveness of child and adolescent mental health (CAMHS) services

The final edition is scheduled for publication in April 2011. The Department has stopped collecting these data and there will no further publications.

Individual Scale Point results for the Early Years Foundation Stage Profile (EYFSP)

This release was last published in March 2010 as experimental official statistics. From 2011, the data for this publication will be published in March as an additional table to the Statistical First Release titled Early Years Foundation Stage Profile Results in England, published in October of the previous year.

Additional tables

In addition to the main releases listed, further information is often released in the form of additional tables. Typically, these may be Local Authority level tables relating to the national tables in the main release, or updated tables using revised or final data. These additional tables will be either identified within the releases themselves or separately advertised on our website. They are not listed separately in this schedule.

Underlying data

As part of a Government drive for improved data transparency, we will simultaneously release the underlying data alongside the main publication, or make it available as soon as possible after the release of the main publication. Where data protection and resources permit, this supporting data will include a combination of files in an open standardised format and data at finer levels of detail.
