

European Arrest Warrant (EAW) Data

Part 1 (incoming) EAW requests

Warrants issued under Part 1 originate from other EU member states. They relate to offences committed in those states by people who are now believed to be elsewhere in the EU, including the UK.

The issue of such a warrant enables a fugitive to be arrested in the UK and extradited to another EU member state to face justice.
