# Public Expenditure 2001-02 Provisional Outturn

# **Total Managed Expenditure**

This White Paper reports provisional outturn figures for public spending in 2001-02 providing information on DEL and AME, including voted spending and administration costs limits. All departments are described as they were constituted at the end of 2001-02.

Spending by the public sector as a whole is known as Total Managed Expenditure (TME). Within TME there are two important aggregates. Departmental Expenditure Limits (DEL) cover spending for which firm three-year plans are capable of being set. Annually Managed Expenditure (AME) is subject to annual review as part of the Budget process.

# **Resource Accounting and Budgeting**

With effect from 1 April 2001, Government spending moved from being accounted for on a cash basis to an accruals basis. This White Paper reports outturn for the main control aggregates and departmental control limits on an accruals basis. As noted above, the outturn figures are provisional and may be subject to some adjustment when the final accounts are available.

#### **Departmental Expenditure Limits**

Provisional outturn for DEL in 2001-02 was £212.361 billion. This is £0.178 billion (less than 0.1 per cent) below the plan figure for total DEL of £212.539 billion. It is £7.018 billion (3.2 per cent) below final departmental limits (which run to more than the limit for total DEL because they include End Year Flexibility entitlements drawn down through Estimates). **Table 1** (resources) and **Table 1a** (capital) shows outturn against original and final limits by department. There were two breaches. The outturn figures form the basis of the calculations to determine each department's End Year Flexibility (EYF) entitlements for DEL shown in Table 6.

# **Annually Managed Expenditure**

Provisional outturn for AME in 2001-02 was £177.504 billion - £2.807 billion (1.6 per cent) lower than the forecast in *Public Expenditure Statistical Analyses* (*PESA*) 2002-03 (*Cm 5401*). **Table 2** shows outturn against the *PESA 2001-02* and *PESA 2002-03* forecasts consistent with the groupings in Table 1.3 of those documents.

#### **Central government voted expenditure**

Provisional outturn in 2001-02 for voted resource spending was £276.372 billion -£8.249 billion (2.9 per cent) less than final provision and for voted cash spending £270.151 billion -£10.471 billion (3.7 per cent) less than final provision. **Table 3** shows outturn, original provision and final provision by Estimate and Request for Resources (RfR). There were four overspends.

# **Administration costs limits**

Provisional outturn in 2001-02 for gross controlled running costs was £16.382 billion - £585 million (3.4 per cent) lower than final limits. **Table 4** shows outturn, original and final administration costs limits for gross controlled administration costs areas. There were three breaches. **Table 5** shows outturn, original and final administration costs limits for net controlled areas. There was one breach.

#### **Breaches**

Whenever a breach of an individual DEL or administration costs limit occurs, the usual corrective procedures will be applied, including an investigation into the causes of the breach, an examination of the financial procedures of the department or body concerned and, where appropriate, a reduction in the corresponding limit in the following year.

#### **End Year Flexibility**

The DEL EYF scheme enables departments to carry forward all of their unspent DEL with no upper limit. Eligible amounts are based on unspent DEL less, where appropriate, DEL Reserve claims agreed during the course of the year plus any EYF entitlements from previous years not taken up. **Table 6** shows the amounts for carry forward into 2002-03 for each individual DEL. Subject to Parliamentary approval of any necessary Supplementary Estimates, individual DELs or administration costs limits will be increased when carry forward is taken up.
