ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION REGULATIONS 2004

Further to my letter of 29th June 2010 concerning Operating Centres based at Herne Place, London, SE24 0EN. My colleagues in the Central Licensing Office have now supplied me with information to allow me to answer the remainder of the points you raised in your e-mail of 20th June 2010.

I can confirm the following:-

- 1) There are no GV79E forms available for any operators based at Herne Place London, SE24 0EN;
- 2) The EU Directive on Industrial Land Use is not relevant to the issuing of Operator Licences;
- 3) There are no copies of plans available with respect to the Operating Centres or buildings as it is not a statutory requirement;
- 4) If the holders of these Operator Licences had not been able to satisfy the requirements on repute set down in legislation they would not have been granted and issued with a licence. Additionally, if their repute was called into question at a later date, the Traffic Commissioner has the authority to revoke an operators licence on the following grounds; lack of repute, failure to satisfy repute or the Traffic Commissioners decision that repute has been lost.
