COMMUNITY CAPACITY (CAPITAL) GRANT DETERMINATION 2013/14: No 31/2219

ANNEX B

GRANT CONDITIONS

- 1. Grant paid to a local authority under this determination may be used only for the purposes that a capital receipt may be used for in accordance with regulations made under section 11 of the Local Government Act 2003.
- 2. The Chief Executive and Chief Internal Auditor of each of the recipient authorities are required to sign and return to the team leader of Social Care Finance in the Department of Health a declaration, to be received no later than March 31 2014, in the following terms:

"To the best of our knowledge and belief, and having carried out appropriate investigations and checks, in our opinion, in all significant respects, the conditions attached to the Community Capacity Grant No 31/2219 have been and will be complied with".

- 3. If an authority fails to comply with any of the conditions and requirements of paragraphs 1 and 2, the Minister of State may
 - a) reduce, suspend or withhold grant; or
 - b) by notification in writing to the authority, require the repayment of the whole or any part of the grant.
- 4. Any sum notified by the Minister of State under paragraph 3(b) shall immediately become repayable to the Minister.
