

The figures do not include one-off payments, i.e. those not made under grant agreements, to ACPO.

Home Office funding to ACPO HQ – ‘grant-in-aid funding’ as described in the below tables – ceased in December 2012. Grant payments for other functions (UK Disaster Victim Identification, National Interoperability Team, Policing the Olympics, PNIICC and NPoCC) have been/are made to ACPO, but they are for functions administered by ACPO and not payments for ACPO itself, nor should they be construed as such.

In addition, the payments described are included as per their accrual date. All figures are rounded up to the nearest £1.
