Overall response to the evaluation: Despite a rigourous ToR, this evaluation fell short of expectations. The Evaluation Team did not envisage a sufficiently large window for field surveys, and the quality of their analysis suffered from this lack of first hand information and evidence. Findings were consequently narrow. However the Evaluation did pick up on some important issues with the programme, notably in the area of programme management.

Planned use of the evaluation: The Evaluation has provided food for thought for the second phase of the Ecoles et Villages Assainis (EVA) Programme, and this Management Response, coupled with a similar recommendations-analysis exercise conducted in a section retreat in August 2012, will contribute to thinking around the design of the second phase. Elsewhere, WASH Section will retain important lessons on the management of Evaluation Teams, their responsibilities, and the responsibilities of UNICEF for receiving quality work as stipulated in the ToR
