Poppy Jaman

Poppy is the Chief Executive of Mental Health First Aid England. She has been a driving force behind the Armed Forces Mental Health First Aid programme, is a founding member of the City Mental Health Alliance management committee and has been instrumental in the development of this initiative, and led the review of the Mental Health Pledge in the Department of Health's Responsibility Deal.

She has worked extensively in the field of mental health literacy among the youth population, engaging with colleges and schools in England to increase the number of people who are Youth MHFA trained. Internationally, Poppy works with the 20 other countries where the MHFA is being taught, reviewing best practice and comparing learnings. She recently visited Uganda at the request of the British High Commission to work with the Ugandan Peoples Defence Force on mental health literacy. Poppy is also supporting the development of the MHFA Bangladesh programme.

Rosie Glazebrook

Rosie chairs a Research Ethics Committee, is a Board member of the Human Tissue Authority and a member of a health research funding board. She represents the public on the Food Standards Agency's Consumer Advisory Panel and Microbiological Safety of Food Committee, and is a Trustee of Book Aid International.

During 2013, Rosie was an External Reviewer for the Clwyd-Hart Review of NHS Complaints. Previously, she worked with NHS London to develop and launch the award winning *myhealthlondon* site. She has held senior commercial positions at Dr Foster, News International, Macmillan Press and Oxford University Press.
