I refer to your email of 11th February 2013. We have dealt with this under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for information relating to the number of tests undertaken per annum at the Heavy Goods Vehicle Testing Stations at Ammanford, Pontypool and Cardiff.

I have attached a spreadsheet to the covering e-mail which gives the monthly throughput by test type at each of these locations for 2011 and 2012.
