

General Information

The Recruit Firefighter Course is designed to teach newly employed firefighters the minimum skills necessary to operate safely on the MOD Estate¹. The course is in 2 parts:

- Part 1 – Formal Training at the Training School
- Part 2 – Continued Formal Training on Station

Part 1 – Formal Training

Part 1 of the course consists of 70 days training (normally spread over 14 consecutive weeks) and currently covers:

- Fire & Rescue Service Core Skills
- Breathing Apparatus Wearing including Compartment Fire Behaviour
- Domestic (Structural) Firefighting including Road Traffic Accidents
- Airfield Fire & Rescue Operations
- Trauma care

Part 2 – Continued Formal Training

Part 2 of the course consists of subjects that are too varied to be taught at the Training School (e.g. Unit Organisation and Structure) and are therefore best covered on return to Station.
